Among all institutions doing research in communication and media, the School's research outputs received the highest percentage of top ratings from the international panel of assessors in the Exercise. To show our care to the community, our faculty has contributed 15 reports on research related to vaccine hesitancy in the HKBU-funded "Overcoming Vaccine Hesitancy in Hong Kong" project. The HKBU FactCheck Service has just celebrated its first anniversary having had a very productive year with the publication of over 100 fact check reports and factual clarifications.


